- Discussion on future QA training






Regular activities of CIQA

- Evaluation of EAEVE yearly activities
- Evaluation of Team Composition 2017
- Evaluation of Post-Visitation Feedback 2017
- Evaluation of outcomes of the ESEVT 2017
- Evaluation of E-learning Feedback
- Evaluation of feedback from GA 2017











Conclusions of CIQA

- In a vast majority of aspects EAEVE is working along the standards and rules
- All except one suggestion of CIQA were accepted
- ENQA Self-Assessment Report was acknowledged
- Return rate of the feedback forms from GA 2017 was low, it should be increased
- 16 out of 18 teams were assembled according to the rules (E-learning course, lack of conflicts of interest, different nationalities, gender, newbies)
- All team members completed E-learning course and declared lack of conflicts of interest



Conclusions of CIQA

- Most post-visitation feedbacks were positive, in the case of two visitations there were critical remarks, and they were communicated to the Director
- The System Wide Analysis 2011-2015 was acknowledged
- All experts passing the E-learning platform found it useful, they were satisfied; some of them had useful comments
- CIQA emphasises that tracking sheet has to be used to all EAEVE documents



Conclusions of CIQA

Overall, CIQA is happy to confirm that activities of EAEVE with minor deviations meet the rules declared in the documents of the Association
