## What is EAEVE?

EAEVE (European Association of Establishments for Veterinary Education) is a non-profit quality assurance organization that applies a rigorous quality assurance system, called the European System of Evaluation of Veterinary Training (ESEVT) when carrying out **Visitations**.

EAEVE's mission is to evaluate, promote and further develop the quality and standard of veterinary medical establishments and their teaching within and beyond Europe.

## This is where you come in...

Visitation requests are increasing every year as Veterinary Education Establishments realize the value of the ESEVT system. Do you want to help **evaluate**, **promote** and **develop** veterinary education in Europe and beyond?

Are you in your **pre-final** or **final year** of university? Are you studying at a member Establishment of EAEVE holding the *Accreditation* status? Do you have a very good grasp of English? Then this could be the perfect opportunity for you...

## How does it work?

1. Send an email to [office@eaeve.org](mailto:office@eaeve.org) with the following attachments:
  - Your CV (in English)
  - A filled in and [signed application form](#) (maximum of 2 pages)
  - Motivation letter (maximum of 1 page)
  - A support letter from an association of veterinary students (in case you are not already a member of IVSA)
2. We will get back in touch with you to let you know if your application has been approved.
3. After approval, you will be assigned to a Visitation Team.
4. Then, there will be a bit of preparation for the Visitation including a short E-learning course.
5. No need to worry about planning or costs; the Establishment to be visited will cover this.
6. The Visitation will take place over five days during a period of full academic activity.
7. You will contribute to the preparation of the Visitation Report by helping the other team members.
