



Call for Candidates

Committee on Internal Quality Assessment (CIQA)

The European Association of Establishments for Veterinary Education (EAEVE) is looking for a suitable individual to fill a position in CIQA for the term May 2017 – May 2020.

CIQA member will be elected by the General Assembly, comprising Deans and Representatives of the Member Establishments. CIQA member will be elected for 3 years, re-election can take place once.

1. Responsibilities

As laid down in EAEVE's [‘Policy for Assurance of Quality’](#), CIQA's main responsibilities are:

- To direct the development, implementation, revision and improvement of quality in the European System of Evaluation of Veterinary Training (ESEVT);
- To present to the EAEVE General Assembly an annual report on the fulfilment of the policies and objectives of internal quality assessment and management and on the proposals and measures taken for improvement;
- To perform a critical review on the development, results and persons involved in all the steps of the annual evaluation processes, including the final decisions taken by European Committee of Veterinary Education (ECOVE), looking for the equal application of the system to all the members without any type of discrimination, and controlling absence of conflict of interest;
- To meet at least 2 times a year¹ and to inform the Executive Committee (ExCom), the Director of the ESEVT and the EAEVE President about the outcome of the meetings.

2. Required Profile

In light of the responsibilities, candidates are expected to fulfil the following criteria:

- Quality Assurance knowledge;
- Experience in ESEVT Visitation in the last 3 years.
